1. 5/- will be collected by the Roll Teachers at Roll Call on ^{Friday} Wednesday, 13th October. This covers cost of papers, report envelope etc.
2. Girls are to assemble each morning at the usual time in the Administration Quadrangle.
3. All text books must be handed in on the day of the examination -- at the entrance to the Examination Room. Bursars will bring books to table near Text Book Store Room.
ALL TEXTBOOKS must be clean.
Textbooks must be tied together, with a slip of paper on top of the pile showing name, class, number of books and name of each textbook in the bundle.
REMEMBER! Books not handed in must be paid for.
4. In the case of illness or sickness, the Principal must be notified immediately i.e. by 9.00 a.m. on the morning of the examination and a medical certificate MUST be presented later.
5. Intermediate Certificate girls:
Remember to bring Science Practical books on the day of the Science Paper (This does not apply to Third Form Examination Candidates).
6. All girls must bring Mathematical instruments for the Mathematics papers - Art equipment for Art examination.
Needlework girls must provide themselves with paste, pins, scissors and coloured pencils.
7. Girls intending to leave school at end of this year must make arrangements with their class Teacher for reference -- hand in the form attached (completed) by Friday, 15th October. No reference will be given unless this is done.
No reference will be given unless ALL textbooks, Library books are handed in and fees paid, (or exemption granted) as well as any other money owing, e.g. Art, Typing, Home Economics, Needlework etc. References will be posted after 14th December. They will not be available before this.
8. Recommendations regarding Pass or Failure in the Intermediate Examination will be announced at school at 11.00 a.m. on Monday, 13th December, 1965.
No phone requests will be handled.
9. SPEECH DAY 14th December.
ALL girls are expected to attend and to be in full school uniform -- summer uniform preferred.
Practice will be held some time on Monday 13th December.
ALL prize winners MUST attend on Monday, 13th December and Tuesday, 14th December.
10. ALL girls continuing to Fourth Form next year must attend regularly to end of year viz. Thursday, 16th December.
Girls who have had their fifteenth birthday and who are not returning to school next year need not attend after 29th October- except for Monday, 13th December and Tuesday, 14th December.
